SMELLS EXPERIMENT

1. **Topic**: The senses.

2. Level: 2° ciclo

3. **Aims**:

- To tell the difference between good and bad smells.
- To test the sense of smell.

4. Resources:

- a. Template 1.1.
- b. Jars with different substance that has a strong smell.

5. Procedures:

Hand out copies of the worksheet (Template1)

The students try to recognize the different substances and write the names. Then correct with the whole class. Finally they ask their partners what is his/her favourite smell.

Teachers note:

Some suggestions for what to put in the jars!: vinegar, lemon juice, onion, mustard, coffee, toothpaste, chocolate, perfume,...

It's very important to think about health and safety and draw up a list of procedures to protect the students from substances that could be dangerous if ingested or brought near the eyes.

6. Variations:

- Fast finishers can add an extra column to write their likes: I like or I don't like.
- This activity can be developed in the 1st cycle with the Template2, when the children just write if it is a good smell, bad smell or no smell.

5. Procedures:


- a. Hand out copies of the worksheets (template3.2).

Divide the class in groups or pairs.


Hand out copies of Template 1, 2, 3 and 4.




